LATEST UPDATE ON OUR SERVICES AND ACTIVITIES

The Government of Kenya, through a Presidential Directive, has taken drastic measures to limit the factors that exacerbate the **spread of COVID-19**. In support of this, Bomas of Kenya has: -

- 1. Suspended its daily cultural performances for 14 days with effect from 17th March 2020, or until further notice.
- 2. Activated our Crisis Management Team to address situations as they arise and, act as will be appropriate;
- 3. Enhanced cleaning of its facilities and introduced sanitizers at all points of entry/exit as well as service points;
- 4. Resolved to continue to work closely with the Ministry of Health and other Health Service Providers to address any emerging issues or cases;
- 5. Planned to have a standby trained health service provider to ensure that both staff on the ground and any walk-in customers are assured of required medical attention; and
- 6. Decided that the Utamaduni Restaurant will remain open to walk-in clients, but will strictly adhere to the directive of "NO LARGE GATHERING".

Bomas of Kenya Management will continue to follow the developments regarding COVID-19 and work with the Government of Kenya in all its mitigation plans.
